

PRIVACY STATEMENT

1. About this Privacy Statement

Covolt B.V. (Covolt, we, us) attaches great importance to the protection of your personal data. In this Privacy Statement, we aim to provide clear and transparent information about how we handle your personal data. Covolt is the data controller with respect to the personal data obtained or generated via the Covolt website (<https://covolt.eu/>), e-mail, SMS, and apps.

If, after reviewing this Privacy Statement, or more generally, you have any questions about it or wish to contact us, you may do so using the contact details at the end of this document.

2. Processing Activities

We process personal data of the following categories of persons:

- (A) customers and suppliers;
- (B) subscribers to our newsletter; and
- (C) prospects, stakeholder and lobby contacts, and/or interested parties.

A. Processing of personal data of customers and/or suppliers

Personal data of customers and/or suppliers are processed by Covolt B.V. for the following purposes:

- Administrative purposes;
- Communication regarding the assignment and/or invitations;
- The execution or issuance of an assignment.

The legal basis for processing these personal data is the agreed assignment.

For the above purposes, Covolt B.V. may request the following personal data from you:

- First name; middle name prefix; last name;
- (Business) telephone number; (business) e-mail address.

Your personal data are obtained by Covolt B.V. upon entering into the agreement and are stored and retained for the purposes of the above processing activities for the duration of the agreement and thereafter only in the financial administration for a maximum period of 7 years.


B. Processing of personal data of newsletter subscribers

Personal data of newsletter subscribers are processed by Covolt B.V. for the purpose of sending newsletters. The legal basis for processing these personal data is the consent given by the individual when completing the Newsletter subscription form.

For the above purposes, Covolt B.V. may request the following personal data from you:

- First name; middle name prefix; last name;
- E-mail address;
- Gender.

Your personal data are obtained by Covolt B.V. upon subscribing to the newsletter and are stored and retained for the purposes of the above processing activities for the period during which the individual remains subscribed.





C. Processing of personal data of prospects, stakeholder and lobby contacts, and/or interested parties

Personal data of prospects, stakeholder and lobby contacts, and/or interested parties are processed by Covolt B.V. for the purpose of providing information in the form of newsletters and/or targeted contacts. The legal basis for processing these personal data is consent in the form of providing a business card and/or via a connection on LinkedIn.

For the above purposes, Covolt B.V. may request the following personal data from you:

- First name, middle name prefix, last name;
- Telephone number;
- E-mail address.

Your personal data are obtained by Covolt B.V. when such data are made available to Covolt and are stored and retained for the purposes of the above processing activities for the period during which the individual is considered a prospect, stakeholder or lobby contact, and/or interested party.

3. Disclosure of data to third parties

The data you provide to us may be disclosed to third parties if this is necessary for the purposes described above or to comply with a legal obligation. For example, we use third parties for:

- Providing the internet environment and software management;
- Providing newsletters and invitations;
- Providing services for the performance of our activities.

We do not provide personal data to other parties with whom we have not concluded a data processing agreement. With these parties (processors), we of course make the necessary arrangements to safeguard the security of your personal data. Furthermore, we will not provide the data you have supplied to other parties, unless this is legally required and permitted. An example is when the police request (personal) data from us in the context of an investigation. In such a case, we are obliged to cooperate and to provide such data. We may also share personal data with third parties if you give us written consent to do so.

4. Transfers outside the European Economic Area (EEA)

We do not provide personal data to parties established outside the European Economic Area (EEA).

5. Minors

We only process personal data of minors (persons under the age of 16) if written consent has been given by a parent, guardian, or legal representative.

6. Retention period

Covolt B.V. does not retain personal data longer than necessary for the purposes for which they were provided, or as long as required to comply with applicable laws and regulations.

7. Security

We have taken appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your personal data against unlawful processing. These measures include, for example:

- All persons who may take note of your data on behalf of Covolt B.V. are bound by confidentiality;





- We apply a username and password policy on all our systems;
- We make backups of personal data in order to restore them in the event of physical or technical incidents;
- We regularly test and evaluate our measures;
- Our employees are informed about the importance of protecting personal data.

8. Rights relating to your data

You have the right to access, rectify, or erase the personal data we have received from you. You may also object to the processing of your personal data (or part thereof) by us or by one of our processors. In addition, you have the right to have the data you have provided transferred by us to yourself or, at your instruction, directly to another party. We may ask you to identify yourself before we can comply with the aforementioned requests.

Where we process your personal data on the basis of consent given by you, you always have the right to withdraw that consent. Newsletter recipients may unsubscribe by clicking the unsubscribe link in the newsletter e-mail or by sending an e-mail to: ****[provide e-mail address]****.

9. Complaints & questions

If you have a complaint about the processing of your personal data, we ask that you contact us directly. If we are unable to resolve the matter together, we of course regret this. You always have the right to lodge a complaint with the Dutch Data Protection Authority (Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens) (<https://www.autoriteitpersoonsgegevens.nl/>)(<https://www.autoriteitpersoonsgegevens.nl/>), the supervisory authority in the field of data protection.
